# ABOUT THE EVENT

The Australian Polocrosse Nationals is the pinnacle of the Australian made sport of Polocrosse and is played biennially in rotation to each Australian state.

In 2026, for the first time in over a decade, the Nationals will be making its way back to Darwin, hosted by the NT Polocrosse Association.

The lush green fields and shady sidelines of Freds Pass Reserve in Darwin's rural area awaits to welcome over 4,000 attendees for a week of high energy polocrosse action, entertainment, market and food stalls.

Polocrosse is an exhilarating equestrian sport that masterfully blends the strategic finesse of lacrosse with the dynamic horsemanship of polo.

Originating in Australia during the 1930s, polocrosse has galloped its way into the hearts of over 6,000 players worldwide, captivating audiences with its fast-paced action and compelling teamwork.

At the core of polocrosse is a strong sense of family, love of horses and community with intergenerational legacy; there is no other sport like it.

Ablution Facilities and Septic Removal	Provision of portable toilets and waster management services.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

## Competition Details

The competition will feature categories for Sub-juniors (under 12), Juniors, Intermediates, Men, Women, and Masters, with an estimated 400 participating athletes.

## Venue & Infrastructure

The venue, Fred's Pass Reserve, offers unlimited seating capacity, with designated spectator zones including a VIP Marquee, bleacher seating, bench seating, and attendees will be encouraged to bring their own camping chairs.

Community engagement zones will feature merchandise booths, market stalls, food stalls, and evening entertainment, creating a lively atmosphere for all attendees.

## Target Spectator Audience

The event aims to attract equine and sports enthusiasts, media and press representatives, corporate sponsors, business stakeholders, government and sporting bodies, local community members, and dry season visitors.

## Entertainment (Proposed)

A diverse range of daily entertainment is planned, showcasing local musicians, crocodile racing, DJ performances, local tours including a Mindil Market bus trip to provide a well-rounded Northern Territory experience for attendees.

## Broadcast & Media Coverage

Media coverage will include social media and digital campaigns. Matches will be broadcast with embedded sponsor assets, ie TVCs, Logo pop-ups. Press conferences and interviews will be handled by the NTPA media spokesperson, ensuring broad media engagement. Full event coverage will be provided through photography and videography for content distribution.

## Marketing & Promotions

Traditional advertising will be employed through NT News, Darwin radio stations, ABC Radio, and potential NT-wide promotion targeting the dry season drive market. Community engagement efforts will involve local stakeholders, the business community, and Fred's Pass User Groups.
